ARRIVAL: May begin arriving Friday, October 3, 2008 after 8:00 a.m.

MUST BE IN PLACE: Must be in place no later than Friday, October 3, 2008 at 12:00 noon.

CHECKING IN: Friday, October 3, 2008 10:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

JUDGING: Saturday, October 4, 2008 at 10:00 a.m.

RELEASE: Sunday, October 5, 2008.

ENTRY DEADLINE: August 29, 2008. Entries must be submitted online or mailed in on an official entry form. Entries submitted online will be accepted until 12:00 midnight on August 29. Entries mailed must be postmarked by August 29.

ENTRY EXTENSION: Entries received prior to August 29, 2008, are able to add additional animals at double head fees until **September 12, 2008.**

LATE ENTRIES: Entries not received prior to August 29, 2008, can enter until **September 12, 2008,** for triple head fees.

SUBSTITUTIONS: Substitutions of animals will be accepted until 12:00 noon the day preceding the show for \$15. Change in ownership is not a substitution.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Entries are open to any and all Boer Goat breeders regardless of state of residents.
2. **SANCTIONING:** This is an American Boer Goat Association sanctioned show and will follow ABGA rules and regulations. The Oklahoma Boer Goat Association will sponsor a belt buckle for the Premier Exhibitor Award. The high point individual will be awarded based on number of animals shown and their placings. 3. **READ GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:** All exhibitors will be required to follow the General Rules and Regulations, Health and Sanitary Regulations and the Show Ring Code of Ethics as outlined in the front of this book.
4. **REGISTRATION PAPERS:** Original registration papers are required at check-in from any recognized association.
5. **HEALTH PAPERS:** All entries are required to have health papers.
6. **FEES:** Processing fees are \$15 per head; payable to Tulsa State Fair.
7. **SHOW RING:** No assistance in show arena.
8. **BEDDING:** Bedding is available to purchase on grounds at the Feed Store at the North end of the Explorer Barn.
9. **DATE OF BIRTH:** Birth dates, as listed on the registration papers will be used to determine the class divisions. The show date will be the base in computing all ages. Take the show date and count back to the birth date of the goat to determine the age and the class for the animal.
10. **BUCKS:** Bucks must be washed daily while on grounds.
11. Any goat showing any pronounced defect or abnormality such as weak constitution, unthrifty condition, overshot jaw or undershot jaw, will be barred from showing in any of the breeding classes.
12. **GROOMING:** No artificial coloring or powdering will be allowed.
13. **PICTURES:** Champion and Reserve Champion animals from each breed must be taken to the backdrop for photographs immediately following completion of each day's show.
