IN PLACE: Must be in place on Thursday, September 25, 2008 at 12:00 noon. May begin arriving on Wednesday, September 24, 2008 after 12:00 noon.

JUDGING: Friday, September 26, 2008 at 2:00 p.m.

RELEASED: Staged Release on Sunday, September 28, 2008.

ENTRY DEADLINE: August 29, 2008. Open Show entries must be submitted online or mailed in on an official entry form. Entries submitted online will be accepted until 12:00 midnight on August 29. Entries mailed must be postmarked by August 29.

ENTRY EXTENSION: Entries received prior to August 29, 2008, are able to add additional animals and classes at double the head fees until **September 12, 2008**.

LATE ENTRIES: Entries not received prior to August 29, 2008, can enter until **September 12, 2008**, for triple head fees.

SUBSTITUTIONS: Substitutions of animals will be accepted until 12:00 noon the day preceding the show for \$15.00. Change in ownership is not a substitution.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Superintendent must finalize their show information by noon the day preceding their show. No changes will be made after this time.

1. The Brahmousin Show will be subject to General Rules and Regulations of the Tulsa State Fair.
2. In addition to the Tulsa State Fair entry fee, a fee of \$25.00 per head is payable to The American Brahmousin Council. This fee will be collected upon arrival at the Fair.
3. All Brahmousin entries must be recorded with the American Brahmousin Council, and exhibitors must be in good standing with the ABC.
4. All animals' tattoos will be checked for legibility and must match the registration papers for that animal. Animals with illegible tattoos or incorrect papers will not be allowed to show.
5. Any animal upon check-in which does not have a legible tattoo corresponding to its registration certificate is ineligible to show. Once disqualified due to an incorrect or illegible tattoo, animals cannot be re-tattooed and rechecked at the show.
6. Animals eligible to be shown in group classes must be entered and shown in individual classes.
7. Cows that are exhibited with calves at side must be in lactating stage. Calves must be shown and exhibited with their dams and must not exceed 240 days of age on day of judging. Calves over 60 days **MUST** have registration papers.
8. Calves under 60 days of age that are being shown in an individual class, besides the cow/calf class, must have registration and tattoos.
9. Animals are eligible for entry in only one individual class with the exception of a calf at the side of a cow. That calf may be entered in an individual class if the appropriate fees are paid and calf follows the above guidelines.
10. Heifers exhibited at 22 months of age or older must be accompanied by certificate of pregnancy.
11. All prize monies will be awarded in individual classes.
12. There will be \$2,000.00 premiums offered. The management of the Tulsa State Fair will pay 100% of premiums directly to the Exhibitors. The American Brahmousin Council will reimburse to Fair management 50% of the premiums paid upon receipt from show management of completed detail show report forms.
