IN PLACE: Must be in place on Thursday, September 25, 2008 at 12:00 noon. May begin arriving on Wednesday, September 24, 2008 after 12:00 noon.

JUDGING: Friday, September 26, 2008 at 10:00 a.m.

RELEASED: Staged Release on Sunday, September 28, 2008.

ENTRY DEADLINE: August 29, 2008. Open Show entries must be submitted online or mailed in on an official entry form. Entries submitted online will be accepted until 12:00 midnight on August 29. Entries mailed must be postmarked by August 29.

ENTRY EXTENSION: Entries received prior to August 29, 2008, are able to add additional animals at double the head fees until **September 12, 2008**.

LATE ENTRIES: Entries not received prior to August 29, 2008, can enter until **September 12, 2008**, for triple the head fees.

SUBSTITUTIONS: Substitutions of animals will be accepted until 12:00 noon the day preceding the show for \$15.00. Change in ownership is not a substitution.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The \$2000.00 Romagnola Show is co-sponsored by the Tulsa State Fair and the North American Romagnola & Romangus Association, with each paying 50% of the premiums offered.

The Superintendent must finalize their show information by noon the day preceding their show. No changes will be made after this time.

1. All Romagnola entries must be registered in the NARRA. Registration certificates are required for presentation before the show. Exhibitors are subject to all rules and regulations of the NARRA and the General Rules and Regulations of the Tulsa State Fair. Tattoos will be checked, must be legible, and correspond with the registration certificate.
2. The surgical or nonsurgical alteration of conformation of an animal is prohibited except for dehorning. Cattle are to be shown in their natural conformation. The use of false tail heads or adding hair, or other material to any part of the animal's body is prohibited.
3. The dyeing or artificial changing of the overall natural color of an animal is prohibited. Coloring agents may be used on the legs and tail switches, but none may be used above the flank.
4. All animals must be dehorned.
5. All cattle shall be made available for veterinary examination to determine the presence of altering. Cattle also will be made available for a veterinary examination to be mouthed for the purpose of age verification. The show Committee reserves the right, after mouthing by a qualified veterinarian, to remove the animal from the show or designate the animal to be shown in a different class from that previously entered, at the Committee's discretion.
6. Exhibitors of heifers 24 months of age or older must have a certificate of pregnancy issued by a licensed veterinarian available for inspection.
7. Processing fees of \$35.00 per head must be paid directly to the Tulsa State Fair.
