**ARRIVAL:** Must be in place on Saturday, October 4, 2008 at 10:00 a.m. May begin arriving on Friday, October 3 after 2:00 p.m.

**JUDGING:** Saturday, October 4, 2008 at 1:00 p.m. in the Explorer Arena.

**RELEASED:** Sunday, October 5, 2008.

**ENTRY DEADLINE: August 29, 2008.** Entries must be submitted online or mailed in on an official entry form. Entries submitted online will be accepted until 12:00 midnight on August 29. Entries mailed must be postmarked by August 29.

**ENTRY EXTENSION:** Entries received prior to August 29, 2008, are able to add additional animals at double the head fees until **September 12, 2008.**

**LATE ENTRIES:** Entries not received prior to August 29, 2008, can enter until **September 12, 2008**, for triple the head fees.

**SUBSTITUTIONS:** Substitutions of animals will be accepted until 12:00 noon the day preceding the show for \$15.00. Change in ownership is not a substitution.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**NO PENDING PAPERS ON ENTRIES WILL BE ALLOWED.**

1. **REGISTRATION PAPERS:** Registration papers will be checked on Friday, October 3 from 3:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. and Saturday, October 4 from 8:00 to 10:00 a.m. at the Swine Superintendent's Office in the Explorer Barn. Only original registration papers will be accepted. No changes will be made after this time. Registration papers must be transferred in the exhibitors name.
2. **PENS:** Pens will be assigned by the designated superintendents. The management reserves the right to pen animals as space permits.
3. **AWARDS:** Animals will be awarded first, second, third, or no premium, according to the merits of the animal and the requirements of the Breed Association they represent.
4. **NO PAPERS PENDING:** The name, registry number and date of birth of each animal must be given. **THIS INFORMATION MUST BE SHOWN ON ENTRY.**
5. **FEEDING:** All pens and alleys adjoining must be cleaned before 8:00 a.m. each day. Feed boxes and containers must be furnished by the exhibitor.
6. **GROOMING:** No paint or other color dressing will be permitted on swine. Only water will be allowed in the holding area.
7. **PREMIUMS:** No exhibitor shall be permitted to receive more than two premiums per class. Individual animals shown in all of the group and herd classes must have been entered and shown in one of the classes for single animals.
8. **HERDSMANSHIP AWARDS:** Swine exhibitors will compete for Herdsmanship Awards under the guidelines in the front of this book.
9. **READ THE GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS:** All exhibitors will be required to follow the General Rules and Regulations, Health and Sanitary Regulations, and the Show Ring Code of Ethics outlined in the front of this book.
10. **PICTURES:** Champion and Reserve Champion animals from each breed must be taken to the backdrop for photographs immediately following completion of each day's show.
11. **COMMERCIAL GILTS:** Commercial gilts will show by weight. The weight range is 220 pounds - 320 pounds. Every effort will be made not to put more than 40 head per class. There will be a 10 pound weigh back for the top 3 gilts in each class. Weigh cards must be turned in by 10:00 a.m. on Saturday.
12. **SCALES:** *Each 4-H County or FFA Chapter will be allowed to purchase a scale permit by submitting a \$25 fee for each permit along with entries. All scales must be used at the end of the aisles. Scale stickers will be issued and must be placed on the upper, right hand corner at the back of the scale.*

**DEFINITION OF AGES OF SWINE**

All animals shall be owned and registered in the name of the exhibitor not less than 120 days prior to the date of showing.
